

CONSTRUCTION HEAD CALLS CONFERENCE AT HOSPITAL

**W. H. Wattis, President Hoover
Dam Builders, Does Not Let
Cancer Stop Interest**

Ogden, Utah, Mar. 12—(UP)—A council of construction will be held in San Francisco Saturday alongside a hospital bed.

Directors of Six Companies, Inc., successful bidders for the construction of Hoover dam on the Colorado river, have been called to San Francisco by their president, W. H. Wattis, suffering with cancer there.

The purpose of the meeting is to departmentize the project and discuss details of the first construction unit, the grading and steel laying of a 20-mile railroad which will be used to haul machinery and material to the dam site.

E. O. Wattis, vice president of Six Companies, Inc., said that at least two miles of this railroad project presented difficult engineering projects.
