

# Worker Injured at Boulder Dam, Dies

Howard Bentley, who was injured on February 5, 1932, when struck by a falling rock in diversion tunnel number two while barring down, and who has been a patient since that time at the Boulder City hospital, is dead.

Bentley had the spinal cord broken when the rock struck him, and he had been completely paralyzed from the waist down ever since that time. Specialists from leading hospitals in Los Angeles had said that Bentley would spend the rest of his life in bed.

Death came at 12:30 o'clock Sunday morning. Bentley, as far as is known by officials, has no surviving relatives. Funeral services were held this afternoon from Park's mortuary chapel, Boulder City, at 1:30 o'clock, with Parson Tom Stevenson officiating.
