

B. and W. Employe Killed in Fall

Fred Deckmann, 20, helper at the Babcock and Wilcox steel fabrication plant at Boulder City, plunged several feet to his death last night while at work on one of the huge pipes being fabricated at the plant.

According to eye witnesses, Deckmann plunged some five feet, landing on the back of his head. His skull was fractured and he died at 10:30 last night, half an hour after he was injured.

The deceased was working with two other men adjusting a clamp on the pipe when, in some manner, the rope holding the clamp snapped, plunging Deckmann off the ladder on which he was standing, to the concrete floor below.

Deckmann is survived by a widow and a 4½ year old child, in Seattle.
