

Carpenter Injured In Fall at Dam

G. L. Shurtleff, carpenter for Six Companies Inc., is at the Boulder City hospital suffering from a broken arm and numerous bruises. Shurtleff, it is reported, was working at an Arizona intake tower when he fell. Shurtleff's right arm was broken at the elbow.

George Baird, laborer for Six Companies Inc., is a patient at the Boulder City hospital, due to a fractured left leg. The manner in which Baird sustained the injury was not learned.

J. Hall, carpenter's helper for Six Companies Inc., who was thought seriously injured following a fall from a form on the dam Saturday, was yesterday released from the Boulder City hospital. Hall sustained only numerous bruises as a result of the fall.
