

Dam Worker's Back Broken in Tumble

Jack Wilson, Six Companies Inc. carpenter, was seriously injured, and Jack Grady, carpenter's helper for the same concern, miraculously escaped injury yesterday morning when they fell 40 feet off the power house on the Arizona side of the river.

Wilson, who toppled off the powerhouse, fell on re-enforcing steel and received a broken back. He is in the Boulder City hospital and doctors said he would recover. Grady, outside of suffering from severe jar, was unhurt.

According to officials, a rope swung across the spot where they were working, sweeping both of them off into the canyon.
