

Boulder Workman Dies of Injuries

Eugene Buckner died this morning at 5:30 a. m., as a result of injuries sustained while at work last evening. Buckner was struck in the face by a timber falling from a jumbo, and suffered injuries to the brain.

Buckner has been in the employ of Six Companies Inc., since February 7 of this year, in the capacity of laborer.

Buckner is survived by a widow, who lives in Cleveland, Tennessee, and a daughter one year old, who also resides in Cleveland, Tennessee, and by his father-in-law, C. M. Davis, who is employed by Six Companies Inc., as a walker on the same shift as that on which Buckner was working.

The remains are at the Park's Mortuary, Boulder City. Funeral services will be held in Cleveland, Tennessee, it is said.
