

Aqueduct Bid Dope Is Revealed In L. A.

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 13. (U.P.)—

Low bids by nationally prominent construction firms on the \$35,000,000 portion of the Colorado river aqueduct, totalled \$16,852,574, according to a tentative estimate. The remainder of the \$35,000,000 cost will be met by the metropolitan water district, supplying materials and engineering supervision.

There were 52 low bids submitted on as many units and while Six Companies Inc., contractors on Boulder dam, failed to show among the low bidders, two member firms of Six Companies, J. F. Shea company of Portland and the Utah Construction company of San Francisco, were low bidders on portions of the work.
