## COMMITTEES WORK

Sunday Will Be Devoted  
To Fete in Boulder,  
Monday Vegas' Day

A monster Labor day celebration, with organized labor of both Las Vegas and Boulder City participating, has been outlined for this section on September 2 and 3, it was announced today by members of the committee in charge following an organization meeting last night.

With a two-day layoff at Boulder dam promised by the officials, all labor in this section is expected to join hands to stage the greatest celebration ever attempted in Clark county.

**THE FIRST** day of the program, Sunday, September 2, will be presented in Boulder City and the festivities are expected to include various sporting events, airplane stunts and special trips over the Boulder canyon project.

Every effort by both Las Vegas and Boulder City will be directed toward making the Boulder City celebration of equal importance to the one in Las Vegas.

**THE SECOND** day's program, on Labor day, will be given in Las Vegas and will start with a monster parade at 9:30 in the morning. The committee expressed the hope that all merchants in Las Vegas will co-operate to make this parade the most notable of its kind ever presented here and in asking the co-operation, it was announced that cash prizes would be offered for the best floats entered in the parade.

All labor organizations, service clubs, veterans organizations and lodges of the twin cities will be invited to participate in the parade, according to the committee.

**A HUGE FREE** barbecue for everyone, with ice cream for the youngsters is planned to follow the parade.

ing carnival will be held with sports for all ages but most of the afternoon will be devoted to the children of the communities and this program will be under the direction of a committee of women.

The evening will be given over to a great labor rally, to be held in Las Vegas, and at which nationally known speakers will be heard.

The rally, according to the committee, will be followed by a monster fireworks display.

**DANCES ARE** being arranged for the evening and the committee has under advisement a number of other features which may be included. One of these is a high class rodeo.

"It is the earnest desire of the committee," according to the members, "to arrange the program to the convenience of the greatest number of residents of the two communities and that the youngsters shall be given all the breaks in the entertainment."
