

Powell's Body Is Still in Lake Mead

Although national park service and bureau of reclamation rangers searched all day yesterday and late Sunday evening, the body of Tom Powell of Boulder City, who drowned Sunday, still has not been recovered from Lake Mead, it was reported today.

The search was continued today, but efforts had been unsuccessful.

Powell drowned late Sunday afternoon while aquaplaning on the lake in Kingman Wash. When the body is recovered, the inquest will be conducted by Arizona officials, as the drowning occurred on the Arizona side of the lake.

Powell was 23 years old and was employed at the Nevada drug store in Boulder City. He fell from an aquaplane into the water, came to the surface shouting and laughing, then became strangled by the water and fought off friends who attempted to rescue him, officers were informed following the accident.
