

Grand Theft Count Faces Dam Worker

R. V. Longley, former carpenter foreman for Six Companies Inc., is being held in the Clark county jail here, on a charge of grand larceny, following his expulsion from the reservation at Boulder City recently.

Longley, according to officers, took a Graflex camera belonging to A. C. Endlein, a fellow worker, and sold it to a merchant in Boulder City for \$10. The camera was valued at \$350 by Endlein.

Officers said that Endlein gave the camera to T. O. Smith for safe keeping while Endlein was in the hospital and that Longley took it from a closet in Smith's room.
