## In Lots of Trouble

Lester King, dam workman, was being taken to the Boulder police station by arresting officer Eddie Kane to be booked on charges of intoxication and disorderly conduct yesterday. This morning the charge of resisting an officer was added to the other two charges, landing the man into real trouble.

King, who was being taken to the jail in a Six Companies Inc. pickup, suddenly opened the car door in an attempt to throw Kane from the running board of the vehicle, and at the same time grabbed the revolver from the holster Kane was wearing. Kane grabbed the man's hand as the prisoner attempted to shoot him, Kane said, and held him until the gun was wrested from his hand.

The man was reported by City Manager Sims Ely to be "wildly drunk," and was being held this morning for Clark county authorities.
