

Dam Project Shuts Down on Labor Day

As is customary, "the Boulder Canyon project will be shut down for the observation of Labor Day holidays, effective with the going off duty of the graveyard shift, at 7:30 o'clock Sunday morning, September 2, and will remain closed down until 7:30 a. m. Tuesday morning, September 4, when the day shift will resume operations," Frank T. Crowe, superintendent of construction for Six Companies Inc., announced this morning. The period of shut-down will be 48 hours, and will involve Sunday, September 2, and Monday, September 3, Crowe said.

Walker R. Young, construction engineer for the bureau of reclamation, this morning stated that the bureau of reclamation would observe the same lay off period as Six Companies Inc.
