

# Powell's Body Is Located Today

The body of Tom Powell, president-elect of the Boulder Boulder City junior chamber of commerce, who drowned in Lake Mead late Sunday afternoon, was recovered this morning by searching parties who have been working ever since the accident.

Powell fell from an aquaplane and drowned about 6 o'clock Sunday evening in Kingman Wash.

National park service and bureau of reclamation rangers, who conducted the search for the body, notified the coroner at Kingman, Arizona, that the remains had been recovered this morning. Since the accident happened on the Arizona side of the lake, the coroner from Kingman will conduct the inquest, and it was not known this afternoon what arrangements for funeral rites would be made.
