

# Dam Memorial Goal Is Fixed at \$800

The goal set for the Central Labor council for the building and erection of a memorial tablet for those who have lost their lives during the construction of the Boulder canyon project is \$800.00, according to R. W. Oliver, chairman of the council's memorial committee.
