Anthony Bednar, employe of the Babcock and Wilcox company, steel fabricators, nearly got the "shock of his life" yesterday when, in some manner, the switch he was holding on one of the "spiders" inserted in a 30-foot pipe section short circuited.

Bednar was immediately taken to the Boulder hospital, where he was put under observation. His condition was reported to be much improved this morning.

The accident occurred in one of the tunnels yesterday.
