

First Car Is Driven Across Boulder Dam

Making good his boast of long standing, that he would drive the first automobile across the top of Boulder dam, Woody Williams, assistant construction superintendent for Six Companies, who has been in charge of canyon operations since the start of the job, today took his Ford V-8 from Nevada to Arizona and back again by the way of Boulder dam.

The fact that three sections remain to be poured did not deter Williams. He overcame that obstacle by putting down planks, thus clinching the honor he had cherished so long.

Mrs. Williams and Ted Davis, rigger foreman, accompanied the Six Companies official on the epochal trip which started at 1:45 this afternoon.

The highway will not be open for travel, however, for several weeks yet, Six Companies officials said.
