

Mason Funeral Is Held in Boulder

Funeral services for Verne Mason were held Saturday afternoon at the Boulder City Latter Day Saints church, with the presiding elder, Lawrence Wortley, officiating. Following the services, remains were sent to Salt Lake City, Mason's former home, for interment.

Mason, 22 years of age, was killed early Friday morning when he fell from a form on the powerhouse structure, badly fracturing his skull. Mason, who was a hook-tender, climbed to the top of the form and was struck by a falling pipe which caused him to lose his balance. During the fall, his head struck a cross-tie, fracturing his skull.

The deceased man is survived by his mother, Mrs. Edward Mason, his step-father, Edward Mason, of Boulder City, and by a sister, Mrs. Virgil Stratton, also of the dam community, all of which accompanied the remains to the Utah city.
