

'MERRY-GO-ROUND' IS ADDED TO DAM CIRCUS EQUIPMENT

Boulder dam now has added a "merry-go-round" to its equipment of candy-wagons and flying trapezes, it was learned this morning from Six Companies Inc.

The new equipment, reminiscent of the "big top," is a revolving boom, located atop intake tower number 6. The revolving boom, or crane, will install the trash racks of the intake towers, each rack of which weighs 4,700 pounds, engineers said today.

The crane, with a boom of 28 feet and 10 inches, runs around on trucks on the concrete parapet on the top of the intake, propelled by an electric motor. Who said construction on Boulder dam wasn't a three-ring circus?
