

# Highline at Dam Is Removed Today

The huge steel cable which has been stretched across Black canyon for over a year from head tower to tail tower of highline number ten has been removed by the rigging department of Six Companies Inc., completing the abandonment of the line which has been used in the construction of the Nevada and Arizona spillways.

The carriage which traversed the big steel wire rope hundreds of times conveying concrete and other materials was removed several days ago. Work on the removal of the cable was completed yesterday.

It is said that parts of the cableway will be used on other cableways on the job. The cable removed from number ten is now being rigged to number eleven highline, and will be used to convey concrete and materials to the Nevada and Arizona valvehouses.
