

ALDEN MILES HURT AT DAM

Alden L. Miles, employe of Six Companies Inc., and resident of Las Vegas, is in a serious condition today as a result of an accident occurring near the Hi-Mix plant of Six Companies Inc. early last evening. Miles is suffering from multiple fractures which include a fractured back, and chest injuries.

Miles, according to eye-witnesses of the odd accident, was hooking a bucket to number nine cableway from a dinkey locomotive on the trestle near the Hi-Mix plant. In some manner, Miles lost his balance, fell off the locomotive, and toppled some 25 or 30 feet to the ground. He landed his feet first, according to reports, and then fell over on his back. The accident occurred at between 7:30 and 7:45 o'clock. The injured man was rushed immediately to the Boulder City hospital.

Miles was the driver of the car which figured in the Levesque accident on the Boulder dam highway on Christmas eve.
