

Magnet to Job Hunters.

DENVER, March 11 (AP)—Between 20 and 30 persons a day are applying for jobs on the Hoover dam. G. A. Bonnet, employment agent for the reclamation bureau here, announced today.

Bonnet said that since the bids were opened for the dam the number of men applying for work has more than doubled.

Besides the men appearing at the office in person, mail applications have increased to about 80 a day, Bonnet said.

The bureau has issued another warning against persons going to Las Vegas, Nev., in the expectation of getting a job.
