

# DAM MEMORIAL PLAQUE OKEH IS SECURED

## Bureau of Reclamation Favors Labor Council Tablet Plan

Permission has been granted the Boulder Central Labor Council by the bureau of reclamation to erect a memorial tablet on Boulder dam, it was learned today by R. W. Oliver, chairman of the memorial committee of the council.

In a letter to Hiram W. Johnson, California senator, Dr. Elwood R. Mead, reclamation commissioner, said "The bureau (of reclamation) and the department are in complete sympathy with the desires of the labor council and an appropriate and satisfactory place for the placing of their tablet will be provided. In addition to this, it is the intention of the government authorities to place a memorial tablet at the base of the flagstaff at or near the dam."

A drive is being made by the council under the direction of Oliver whereby funds for the construction of the tablet are being gathered from both Boulder City and Las Vegas residents.
