

Weather Is Fine

In Boulder in 1934

Weather, a universally infallible topic of conversation, was "fine" in Boulder City and on the Boulder Canyon project, during 1934, as is shown by the annual report of the bureau of reclamation.

During the year of 1934, the highest recorded temperature on the project was 123 degrees, occurring in Black Canyon on July 27, and the minimum was 30 degrees, recorded in Boulder City on December 29. The maximum recorded temperature during December was 75 degrees, and the minimum was 30 degrees. In 1934 the mean temperature was 74.1 degrees.

Rainfall during December amounted to 0.44 inches, raising the total precipitation for the year to 3.11 inches.
