

# WEATHER FINE IN FEBRUARY IN BOULDER CITY

Weather was fine in Boulder City last month, and here are the figures to prove it.

Rainfall in Boulder has been much heavier than usual this year with a total of 2.91 inches. Rainfall during February amounted to 1.79 inches.

BOULDER CITY was 10 degrees warmer this February than during February of 1931, and three degrees colder than last winter, say United States bureau of reclamation reports. The maximum temperature for February of this year was 80 degrees F., and the minimum was only 36 degrees F.

The flow of the Colorado river as gauged at the Bright Angel checking station, in Grand Canyon, varied from 4,500 cubic feet per second to 6,500 cubic feet per second. At the Black canyon checking station, downstream from the dam, the flow varied from 0 to 6,530 cubic feet per second. Storage in the reservoir on February 28 was approximately 110,000 acre feet, and the flow downstream amounted to 201,682 acre feet during the month, or a total flow into the reservoir during February of approximately 311,682 acre feet.

WATER PUMPED to the storage tank of the Boulder City water supply system amounted to 14,342 gallons. Electrical energy used during February amounted to 3,236,000 kwh.
