

IMPERIAL JOB BIDS ARE OPEN

With a bid of \$4,374,240, three firms—Morrison-Knudsen, Winston Brothers, and the Utah Construction company—today were found to be low bidders on the Imperial job at Yuma, according to advices received in Boulder City.

The three companies, who entered a joint bid, were expected to be awarded the contract by the government for the erection of the dam and desilting plant at Yuma.

The Callahan Construction company of Los Angeles, was second low with a bid of \$4,526,000 and the J. F. Shea and General Construction companies' joint bid was third low with \$4,640,000.

The highest bid of the seven presented was that of Henry J. Kaiser company, at \$6,370,164.

All bids will be sent to the reclamation service headquarters at Denver for checking.
