

# BOULDER POLICE CRACK DOWN ON DRUNK DRIVERS

Six Persons Arrested by  
Rangers, Turned Over  
To County Officials

The city management and the police department of Boulder City today, with the cooperation of the district attorney's office, "cracked down" hard on drunk drivers arrested over the week-end period.

Mr. and Mrs. William Kearney were arrested at the reservation gate at 12:10 Sunday morning and taken to the Boulder City police station to be held for charges of drunk and reckless driving. They spent yesterday in jail and today their case was turned over to District Attorney Roger Foley.

F. F. KITCHLER, youthful Boulder resident, was arrested at 2 o'clock yesterday morning and charged with recklessly driving an automobile when under the influence of liquor. Kitchler was accompanied by a young girl, who officers took to her home, and by Gerald Blackburn, of Las Vegas. When arrested, Kitchler stated that he was just leaving to return to Las Vegas. He was bound over to the district attorney.

Bill Hale and Mr. and Mrs. E. L. Godbey were arrested at 3:10 Sunday morning. Hale was charged with drunk driving and disturbing of the peace while Mr. and Mrs. Godbey were charged with drunkenness and disturbance of the peace. Hale was turned over to the district attorney, and Mr. and Mrs. Godbey were permanently expelled from the reservation. Godbey was a bureau of reclamation employe.
