

SOUTHERN UTAH EYES DAM POWER

Southern Utah is preparing for possible use of Boulder dam power in the development of their area, according to word received here today from Cedar City, where a meeting will be held tomorrow night to discuss this particular topic.

Representatives from Nevada and Utah are meeting with the Cedar City chamber of commerce and the Lincoln county chamber of commerce, and invitations have been sent to all civic organizations in the two counties, to city officials, county commissioners and others interested.

The meeting is a result of efforts on the part of Representative L. L. Burt, Lincoln county, and R. J. Shay, president of the Cedar City chamber of commerce. Mr. Burt recently conferred with Mr. Shay on the possibility of extending a transmission line into Utah, in order to increase Nevada's demand for power, under the secretary of the interior's allotment. Possibilities for development of southern Utah's mining and agricultural resources will be enhanced by the prospects for this power, it is said.
