

DAM POWER IS NEVADA HOPE OF THE FUTURE

Snyder Properties Chief
Says Pioche Power Line
Needed

CALIENTE, Feb. 15.—(Special)—“Nevada must look to Boulder dam power for much of its future prosperity, and Pioche is the place to begin, as we have the setup all ready,” it was said last Saturday by J. H. Buehler, manager of the extensive properties of the Snyder interests in that camp.

“Whenever the state and government authorities reach an agree-

ment on the construction of the proposed power line from the dam to Pioche, and the latter has been allotted money for construction, as we hope it will, we can build the line in ninety days and have it completed before the power is available, which will be about next September.”

THE PLAN includes a reduction and refining plant capable of handling several thousand tons daily, where the crude ore will be reduced and the lead and zinc will be refined. There will also be valuable by-products such as sulphuric acid, plaster and manganese.

In connection with the latter Mr. Buehler said that when the proposed plant was a reality and in full capacity the recent fifty per cent cut in the tariff on Brazilian manganese would cost his company \$900 a day, or \$324,000 a year.
