

RIVER AUTHOR ON NEW TRIP

Lewis C. Freeman, famed author, and E. A. McGilvry of San Marino, California, are battering down the barriers of one of the United States' last frontiers as they explore the new region formed by the damming of the waters of the Colorado river.

Freeman, author of "Down the Grand Canyon," "The Colorado River Today and Tomorrow," and numerous other works, with McGilvry leased a 16-foot skiff equipped with a small outboard motor from Murl Emory, famed Colorado river navigator. Freeman and McGilvry have left for the mouth of the Grand Canyon and expect to spend nearly a week exploring that region.

Freeman expects to include his findings in a new book to be published soon.
