

Bar to Aid Dam Power Allotment

A special committee from the State Bar association has been appointed "to cooperate in supervision of power distribution from Boulder dam," it was announced in Reno recently.

George S. Brown of Reno was named temporary chairman of the group, and other members are: Marion B. Earl, A. W. Ham, Charles Lee Horsey and Leo A. McNamee of Las Vegas, and J. A. Sanders, W. V. Ames, Ernest S. Brown and A. J. Maestretti of Reno. All are Bar association members.

Brown announced, according to the Reno papers, that he will call a meeting of the committee within the next few days to select permanent officers and draw up plans for assisting in the development of the Colorado river project.

The group has been selected, he explained, to act primarily as an advisory board in regard to the legal matters involved in putting the Boulder dam resources to use.
