

No More Delays in Ferry Service, Said

There will be no more delays in ferry service across the Colorado river at the dam site, James Cashman, owner of the ferry, said this morning in announcing the installation of a paddle-wheel equipment to replace the old propellor style.

This is expected to eliminate the difficulties of operation experienced since the lake has begun to fill, Cashman said.

The trip now covers a mile and a half and requires about half an hour to complete, Cashman states.

A telephone is being installed on the Arizona side so motorists approaching from that direction can summon the ferry, the owner said.
