

Vegas Power Plea Denied in Carson

CARSON CITY, Oct. 28. (U.P.)—An application by the city of Las Vegas for an allotment of electric power from Boulder dam was denied Saturday by the Colorado river commission at Carson City.

The commission's decision follows:

"Whereas, the Colorado river commission believes that the applicant, the city of Las Vegas, is not at this time qualified to enter into a contract with the commission for the purchase of power for the reason that the commission is of the opinion from the showing made that the city of Las Vegas has not, as yet, been legally authorized to acquire the facilities for using the power.

"Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the commission will continue this hearing for a reasonable time to permit the applicants to qualify by following the statutory steps necessary to the satisfaction of the commission that the applicant will be in a position to use the Boulder dam power for which application is made."
