

BOULDER LAKE

59 MILES LONG

Boulder lake is now fifty-nine miles long according to a statement made by the bureau of reclamation this morning. The approximate rise is three feet in elevation a day. A gradual increase in the flow of water is shown, with the present reading being 35,300 second feet.

The lake now is about 182 feet in depth, the water having reached elevation 822 near the dam. It was explained that the water is at a depth even with the finished portion of the powerhouse structure, on the downstream face.
