
The Boulder dam-Pioche power line program moved one step closer to realization, it was revealed by press dispatches from Washington today, when detailed application for the line was filed with the PWA administration.

Just what action will be taken on the plan had not been learned, but it was understood that the application would be considered at an early date and some definite action started.

A hearing on the proposed line is scheduled to be held either in Pioche or Las Vegas on June 11 and 12, at which time all data concerning the construction plans will be presented to officials of the state.

It is understood that a meeting of the state planning board will be held at the same time as the power line hearing, at which several matters of great importance to the dam area will be discussed.

It was revealed in press dispatches from Washington that recommendations that \$25,000,000 of the PWA funds be allotted to the mines bureau for development of so-called strategic minerals, had been made to the works administration by the western congressional group.

If this fund is established, it is understood that a large portion of it will be allocated for work in the Boulder dam section.
