

Hurt At Dam, Tourist Sues Six Companies

LOS ANGELES, June 26. (U.P.)—Injured, when a wooden foot bridge gave way while she was watching construction of Boulder dam. Alean T. Reeve today filed a \$3,000 damage suit against Six Companies Inc. in the superior court here.

Miss Reeve, in her complaint, declared that she suffered a wrenched back and severe nervous shock in the accident on February 9, 1935.

She alleges that Six Companies was negligent in not supplying safe footing for visitors and that as a result she was injured.

It is understood that Miss Reeve was a tourist who visited the construction work on the Boulder canyon project with guides supplied by an organization in Boulder City.
