

# Will Determine Fate of Power District in Lincoln County

Hearing by the public service commission on the proposal to create a power district in Lincoln county, for the purpose of constructing a transmission line to carry Boulder dam power into the Pioche area, will be held tomorrow morning at the Lincoln county seat, with Chairman Harley A. Harmon of the Nevada public service commission presiding.

This hearing is for the purpose of determining, under the enabling act passed at the last session of the legislature, whether the necessity for the formation of such a district exists, and if the commission finds it does, an order will be issued setting up the district.

The next step in carrying out the construction program would then be to make application to the public works administration for a loan secured by bonds of the district, in turn secured by contracts for sale of the power to the mining companies of the district at a rate sufficient to retire the bonds over a period of time.

The hearing is expected to be widely attended, with Ed. W. Clark, veteran member of the Colorado river commission, A. C. Grant, member of the state planning board, and Oliver Goerman, secretary of the Las Vegas chamber of commerce, representing the Las Vegas area.
