

DAM LAKE NOW 209 FEET DEEP

Boulder lake is now at an elevation of 849.8 feet, according to reports from the bureau of reclamation this morning, making the lake 209 feet deep.

Recordings made at Bright Angel yesterday showed an inflow at that point of 73,800 cubic second feet with a tunnel flow of 16,750 cubic second feet.

The lake at the present time is 68 mile slong and rose approximately four feet in elevation yesterday, which shows a foot advance rise over former readings.
