

ARGUMENT COMPLETED IN BOULDER DAM ACTION

Washington, March 11.—(A)—Oral argument in the attempt to throw out of the supreme court Arizona's challenge of the validity of the Boulder Canyon act ended today with counsel for that state occupying most of the time. Argument advanced for Secretary Wilbur and the states of California, Utah, New Mexico, Colorado, Wyoming and Nevada that the suit be dismissed was presented yesterday. Clifton Mathews, counsel for Arizona, emphasized the injustice and inequity of the act of congress and the compact from the viewpoint of that state, asserting it would deprive Arizona of all water in the river unless it was willing to join the compact of the other six states.
