

Rim of Lake Highway Job Begun Monday

Construction of the Rim of the Lake highway, to follow Boulder lake from Overton to a point near Vegas Wash, started on Monday of this week, when the CCC camp assigned to that project sent the first contingent of workers onto the new project.

This highway will be one of the most scenic in the southwest, and will be completed within the next 18 months.

A 200 man camp has been assigned to Overton for the summer to carry on the construction work, and will work from the eastern end of the highway.

In the fall, an additional camp will be moved in from the north, and will start construction work from the western end where it joins with the Boulder Dam highway near Midway.

It is expected that between a year and eighteen months will be required to complete the project.
