

# June Tourist Travel Breaks All Records

Altho the tourist travel to Las Vegas and Boulder City has shown a slight decrease over the records set during the month of May, the tourists have been flocking here in greater numbers this June than during any other previous June month since the dam was started, according to figures released today by the bureau of reclamation.

Over the past week-end, the figures revealed, there were 3,060 visitors at the dam, coming in 974 automobiles. The figures for last week-end, the reclamation officials said, were 3,401 visitors in 1,083 cars.

According to a check made by the officers at the reservation gates, there has been a steady increase of eastern and middle western tourists passing thru the gate and it is believed that this travel is the main reason for the increase in the June tourist travel.

It was understood, from several sources, that the San Diego fair is attracting many eastern tourists and that they are either stopping in Las Vegas and Boulder City enroute to the fair or on their return trip from the exposition.

Hotels, both in Las Vegas and Boulder City, reflect the figures of the reclamation bureau, the proprietors declaring that the eastern and middle western tourist travel has increased greatly over any summer season in the past five years.
