

DAN COSTELLO, SIX COMPANIES EMPLOYEE, DEAD

Insurance Department
Head Passes in S. F.
This Morning

Dan Costello, popular Six Companies employe, who since the early stages of Boulder dam construction was connected with the insurance department, passed away suddenly in San Francisco this morning at 8:10 o'clock, according to word received at Boulder City.

Costello was a familiar figure on the project and was known by virtually every one of the several thousand employes with whom he came into contact regularly.

FOR SOME time he served as assistant to Ed Brockman in the insurance department, taking a tentative charge when the latter left the project over a year ago.

Costello had been in ill health for the past three months, leaving his post to enter a hospital in San Francisco for treatment for a combination of kidney and head disorders.

HE IS SURVIVED by his widow, a brother, John, and his parents, all of whom reside in San Francisco.

Deceased was 32 years old, native of California, and a graduate of St. Mary's college of Oakland. Remains are at Riley's Funeral Parlor in San Francisco and services will be held from St. Paul Catholic church, San Francisco, Wednesday morning, probably at 9:45.
