

# Lake Water Flow Continues to Fall

The flow of water into Boulder lake, according to recordings made at Bright Angel, still continues to drop. Today's readings showed a decrease of over 37,000 cubic second feet in the last week with the present recording being 67,400 in comparison to 105,000 cubic second feet of last Thursday, June 20.

There are 14,500 cubic second feet being let out through the tunnels. Present elevation is 899 feet, or four feet above the base of the intake towers. The lake is now seventy-six and one-half miles long.
