

Dam Exhibit Being Shipped To NEA Meet

A complete Boulder dam exhibit, featuring a miniature working model, is being shipped to Denver today by Superintendent Maude Frazier of the local public schools, who will conduct a "tourist bureau" in the lobby of the Brown-Palace hotel during the annual convention of the National Educational association which gets under way Sunday afternoon for a five day period.

It is expected that approximately 10,000 of the nation's educators and their families will be present to view the exhibit in addition to the thousands of Denver's own population who will drop in.

Miss Frazier has arranged an attractive photographic history of the great project, together with many interesting exhibits such as pieces of the huge cable, power line, safety belts, hard hats, rivets and other things, while Earl Brothers of the Boulder City theatre, is shipping a small model of the dam to Denver for use in the display.

Road maps, showing the best and most direct routes from Denver to the dam, will be part of the exhibit, while Miss Frazier expects to be present most of the time to answer any questions that might be propounded.

Following the N. E. A. convention, the superintendent will continue on east returning to Las Vegas about August first.
