

BOULDER LAKE HAS MUCH WATER

Boulder lake is now 79 miles in length and contains 3,875,000 acre feet of water, bureau of reclamation engineers said this morning.

The flow of the Colorado river is steadily dropping, and was recorded at Bright Angel this morning to be running the rate of 44,800 cubic feet per second. A total of 15,000 cubic feet per second is being released thru diversion tunnel number one, allowing for storage of 29,800 cubic feet per second.

The Colorado river was flowing yesterday at the rate of 48,400 cubic feet per second.

The elevation of Boulder lake yesterday was 910.8.
