

KINGMAN ROAD

OPENS AUGUST 15

The new Boulder City-Kingman highway is to be ready for travel, but not oiled, on August 15, according to the contract the H. J. Hagen company, contractors, has with the state of Arizona.

Walker R. Young, construction engineer of the Boulder canyon project, said this morning that, in all probability, the section of highway leading from the Arizona abutment of the Boulder dam to the high saddle just east of the dam would be ready for travel on August 15. Young added, however, that the highway across the top of the dam might not be opened for travel by that date.

The section of the road leading from the dam which is being built by Six Companies Inc. is now well under construction.
