

Construction Relic Found at Boulder

A "relic" of early construction days presented itself in Boulder City late yesterday afternoon, much to the astonishment of J. M. Brandt, manager of the Boulder City company's drug store.

According to Brandt, a dam workman came to the store, made a purchase, and presented in payment a coin of the scrip coined for Six Companies Inc., nearly two years ago. The token was accepted.

Scrip, issued to employes of the contracting firm, was abolished nearly two years ago. It is estimated that well over a hundred dollars' worth is still in circulation, probably in the hands of curio collectors.
