

TEMPERATURE OF DAM LAKE RISES

Boulder lake was approximately five degrees warmer on July 1 than on June 1, when the temperature rose from 67 degrees to 72 degrees, bureau of reclamation records showed this morning.

During the month of June, the discharge of the Colorado river ranged from a minimum of 45,200 cubic feet per second on June 6 to 105,000 cubic feet per second on June 19, it was stated today.

The mean flow of the Colorado river during the month at Bright Angel checking station was 67,880 cubic feet per second, and 16,322 cubic feet per second at the Black Canyon checking station.

The runoff of the river during the month was 4,039,138 acre feet at Bright Angel, and 971,206 cubic feet at Black Canyon, according to the monthly report of the bureau
