

FALL ON STAIRS KILLS DAM MAN

Robert V. Miller Fatally Hurt in Plunge at Six Companies Dorm

Robert V. Miller, Six Companies employe, stumbled and fell down two flights of stairs leading from the second floor of dormitory number one in Boulder City, and sustained injuries which caused his death at 5 o'clock this morning.

Miller resided in the dormitory and apparently started down the stairs about 8:30 last evening when he lost his balance and plunged head first to the bottom.

OTHER WORKMEN, sitting in a parked car near by didn't see him fall, but heard the noise, and upon investigation, found him lying unconscious at the foot of the stairs.

He was rushed to the Boulder City hospital, where he regained consciousness at 9:30, and appeared to be in fair condition. He took a turn for the worse toward morning, however, and died about five o'clock.

THE EXACT cause of death had not been determined this afternoon, being ascribed to a "head injury" by attending physicians.

An inquest will be held in Boulder City at 7:30 tonight by Judge Marion B. Earl.
