

# BOULDER LAKE

## 81 MILES LONG

---

Boulder lake, now 81 miles long, has a surface elevation of 918.9 feet, reclamation bureau officials said this morning.

The Colorado river, at the Bright Angel checking station, is running at the rate of 32,600 cubic feet per second, and water is being released from the reservoir at the rate of 15,200 cubic feet per second.

Reclamation officials said today that the rise of Boulder lake would be slow from now on, due to the fact that the lake bed is wider in the upper reaches than in proximity to Boulder dam.
