

# DAM LAKE NOW PAST STATE LINE

Boulder lake, in its upper reaches, is now 15 miles beyond the Nevada-Arizona state line, according to the bureau of reclamation.

The lake, which was 82 miles long this morning, contains 1,130,000 acre feet of water. The surface of the ever-growing body of water is at elevation 919.

The Colorado river, which has been dropping consistently during the past several days, was running this morning at the rate of 32,600 cubic feet per second today. Water at the rate of 15,150 cubic feet per second is being released from Boulder lake thru diversion tunnel number one.
